FIRE BURN BAN



The Council of the **Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254** has issued an open fire burn ban within the boundaries of <u>all property</u> in the RM of Loreburn No. 254

ALL OPEN FIRES ARE PROHIBITED

<u>EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, fireworks or open fires are prohibited in the area mentioned above. This includes burning barrels, fire pits, fire rings, chimineas, and the like are not allowed until further notice.</u>

Self contained incinerators, CSA – approved portable gas fire pits, barbeques, pressurized stoves and charcoal briquettes will be permitted at this time.

Contravention of this ban will result in fines, in accordance with the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254's Respecting Fire Restrictions Bylaw No. 07-2023. Please be advised that if the Fire Department is called to attend a fire as a result of burning during the fire ban, the fire response fees will be billed directly to the owner or occupant of the land and will be added to the taxes if not paid within 30 days.
