

Mail – in Ballot Voting Instruction Sheet

The Mail-in Ballot voting bylaw 08-2024 is on the RM of Loreburn website under the Election tab.

You have been provided with a Mail-In Ballot package. This package includes:

- 1 (or more) Ballot(s) for the office of Councillor and/or Reeve
- 1 Ballot Security Envelope (A)
- 1 Voter Confirmation Envelope (B)
- 1 Outer Envelope with the words Mail-In Ballot on the outside(C)
- 1 Mail-In Ballot Voting Instruction Sheet (this sheet)

Step – by – Step Voting Instructions

- Mark the Ballot(s) by placing an X in the circle to the right of the name of the candidate you are choosing. You are entitled to vote for one (1) candidate for the council position and one for the Reeve position.
- Fold the Ballot(s) and place them in the Ballot Security Envelope (A)
- Seal Envelope (A) and place it in the Voter Confirmation Envelope (B)
- Sign and Date the appropriate section on Envelope B.

NOTE: If you do not sign and date the Voter Confirmation Envelope (B), your vote will not be counted.

- Seal Envelope B and place it in the Outer Envelope (C).
- Seal Envelope C and submit it the RM office by:
 - a) Dropping it off in-person at 562 Main Street, Loreburn, SK; or
 - b) Mailing it to the RM Office at PO Box 40, Loreburn, SK S0H 2S0

Note: Envelope is already supplied with postage in ballot kit

Envelope C must be **RECEIVED** by the RM's Returning Officer no later than

8 pm on November 13, 2024
