



To vote in an RM election in Saskatchewan, you must:

- be a Canadian citizen;
- be at least 18 year of age

You are only allowed to vote in the election once for division if you are eligible for that division and once for Reeve.

### **Municipal Voters - Rural Municipalities only**

On the day of the election, I: *(complete one)*

- (a) have resided in the rural municipality for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election;
- (b) am the registered owner, (or purchaser pursuant to a bona fide agreement for sale), of land in the rural municipality;
- (c) am assessed with respect to land in the rural municipality pursuant to a lease, licence, permit or contract in agreement with the registered owner;
- (d) am assessed with respect to an improvement in the rural municipality;
- (e) am the holder of a permit in the rural municipality with respect to a trailer or mobile home;
- (f) am the spouse of a person described in clause (b), (c), (d) or (e);
- (g) am the chief executive officer of a duly incorporated co-operative, corporation or religious association that is assessed on the last revised assessment roll with respect to property in the rural municipality that is not exempt from taxation.

Where an RM is divided into divisions, each voter is entitled to vote for Reeve and one division councillor. The division a person is eligible to vote in is determined by the **first applicable cause** as listed above. Your property tax notice contains the division that you are eligible to vote for on the bottom right-hand corner of the notice.

You must also bring ID with you to be able to vote:

- Photo ID is your best option, it has your photo, name and address. Ex. Driver's License, ID Card from SGI or any other valid government -issued photo ID that has a photo, name and address.
- Non-Photo ID option you need to present two pieces of ID and both must contain your name and one contains your address.
