

BYLAW NO. 1/76

PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD.

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LOREBURN NO. 254, LOREBURN, SASK.,  
ESTABLISHING A PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD.

WHEREAS, the council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254  
deems it expedient and advisable that recreation be under the management of a  
Parks and Recreation Board;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254  
Loreburn, Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. THERE SHALL BE formed a Parks and Recreation Board in amalgamation  
and conjunction with the villages of ELBOW, LOREBURN, STRONGFIELD,  
and HAWARDEN PARKS and RECREATION BOARDS.
2. THERE SHALL be appointed by Council a member to each of the villages  
PARKS and RECREATION BOARDS.
3. THE MEMBER shall hold office for a term of two (2) years and shall  
be appointed by Council at the October regular meeting of Council.
4. THE MEMBER shall hold office until his successor is appointed.
5. THE MEMBER shall attend the meetings of their villages Parks and  
Recreation Board and shall act as a member of such Board representing  
the Municipality.
6. THIS BYLAW shall come into force as from the 12th day of February,  
A.D. 1976.
