BYLAW NO. 06-2023

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL ESCAPED IRRIGATION ON PUBLIC ROADWAYS WITHIN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LOREBURN NO. 254

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Escaped Irrigation" Bylaw.
- 2. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "Irrigation System" means the application of applying controlled amounts of water to one's property to enhance agriculture growth;
 - b) "**Roadway**" means that part of a public highway located within the municipality designated or intended for use by vehicles, and includes the roadbed structure involving any side slope or ditch bottom, but does not include a designated trail within the meaning of *The Snowmobile Act* or any other trail or path for which a permit is required;
 - c) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254;
 - d) **"Designated Officer"** means the official appointed to act on behalf of the municipality to enforce this bylaw or the Administrator of the municipality.
- 3. No person shall operate irrigation systems in such a manner that water is caused or permitted to escape from the irrigated land into the roadway.
- 4. A Designated Officer who has the reason to believe that a person has contravened a provision of this bylaw may service on that person a Notice of Violation, which Notice of Violation shall indicated that the Municipality will accept voluntary payment by a date specified therein, in the amount as follows:
 - a) First Offence: Verbal warning followed up by written warning or notice of violation to any person committing a first or second offence under this bylaw within three (3) days of the offence to be delivered by registered mail or served in person by a Designated Officer;
 - b) Second offence: \$500.00;
 - c) Third and subsequent offences: \$1,000.00.
- 5. The amount specified in Section 4 of this Bylaw may be paid:
 - a) In person, during regular office hours, to the municipality at the Municipal office; or
 - b) By e-transfer; or
 - c) By mail addressed to the RM of Loreburn No. 254, PO Box 40, Loreburn, SK, S0H 2S0.
- 6. If payment as provided in Section 4 of this Bylaw, is made prior to the due date noted on the Notice of Violation, the person shall not be liable to prosecution for that offence.
- 7. Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction;
 - a) In the case of an individual, to a fine of not more than \$10,000; and
 - b) In the case of a corporation, to a fine of not more than \$25,000.

- 8. The imposition of Notice of Violation or fine for any contravention of this bylaw shall not relieve the person from complying with this bylaw.
- 9. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from the day of final passing thereof.
