BYLAW NO. 12-2023

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES

Whereas, the Tire Stewardship of Saskatchewan provides Saskatchewan residents an opportunity to participate in responsible scrap tire stewardship by placing their scrap tires into the recycle stream, therefore,

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Loreburn No. 254 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned or operated transfer station located within the boundaries of the Municipality;
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard;
3. A person who contravenes the provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality;
4. Bylaw 03/99 be hereby repealed.
