



MAIL IN BALLOT APPLICATION PROCESS

A voter who wishes to vote by mail shall apply for an application package:

- a) in person at the Municipal Office at 562 Main Street, Loreburn, SK;
- b) by mail to the Municipal Office at PO Box 40, Loreburn, SK S0H 2S0;
- c) by email to the Municipalities general email address, office@rm254.ca

An application, package to vote using a mail-in ballot , (Form R) must be received by the returning officer or other designated election official no later than 30 days before election day.

Form R may be returned:

- a) In person before the returning office or other designated election official to witness the person's signature: or
- b) By registered mail, by ordinary mail or by email, in which case the declaration must be accompanied by:
 - i. the person's signature, which digital signatures received electronically are acceptable; and
 - ii. for declaration received electronically or by ordinary mail, copies of identification
- c) A person applying for a mail in ballot electronically or by ordinary mail may be required to attend in person at the election office if their application, including all supporting documentation, is incomplete, unclear, illegible or otherwise unsatisfactory as determined by the returning office or other designated election official.

Upon receiving a Voter's Registration Form, the Returning Officer shall note the date of approval in the appropriate area in the Voter's Registration Form.

Your Mail – In – Ballot package will be sent out after the Call for Nomination closes on 7 October 2026.
